NOTICE No. 12/2022

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1, point 4 of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2020, item 310, 284, 695, 782, 875) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on Inland Navigation (Dz. U. /Journal Of Laws/ of 2019, item 1568, 1901, 2170 of 2020, item 284), the Regional Water Management Board in Gdańsk informs that:

From 30 April 2022, the following waterways under the Regional Water Management Board in Gdańsk administration shall be opened to navigation:

- Szkarpawa River,
- Wisła Królewiecka River,
- Nogat River,
- Jagiellonian Canal,
- Tuga River(restrictions),
- Elbląg River, Drużno lake and Elbląg Canal to Całuny slipway,
- Elbląg Canal from Buczyniec to Miłomłyn.

From 30 April 2022 the following slipways of the Elbląg Canal are in operation:

- Buczyniec, Kąty: from Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m to 8:00 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays from 7:00 a.m to 8:00 p.m.
- Oleśnica, Jelenie, Całuny: from Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m to 7:00 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays from 7:00 a.m to 7:00 p.m.

From 30 April 2002 the following locks are in operation:

 Biała Góra, Szonowo, Rakowiec, Michałowo: from Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m to 7:00 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays from 7:00 a.m to 7:00 p.m. (lockage of cargo vessels beyond the above-mentioned working hours is possible upon prior agreement with the facility manager at least 24 hours in advance).

We would also like to inform that detailed information on the conditions and possible restrictions on navigation on the above-mentioned waterways will be published on an ongoing basis in the daily Fairway Information at https://gdansk.wody.gov.pl.
