Notice to Skippers No. 20/2022

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1, point 4 of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U./Journal of Laws/ of 2017, item 1566) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on Inland Navigation (Dz. U./Journal of Laws/ of 2001 No. 5, item 43) the Regional Water Management Board in Gdańsk informs that:

military drill will be organised on the Vistula River from 13 to 19 May 2022.

During the drill, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., the waterway of the Vistula River will be closed for navigation from km 806+000 to km 807+500.

Please exercise extreme caution and pay attention to the displayed navigation signs: A1 - no passage and B.8 - the obligation to exercise extreme caution.

During the drill, there is a possibility to travel across the aforementioned section of the Vistula River on the condition of obtaining the permission from the organiser 24 hours in advance. The organiser is represented by P. mjr. Martyna Kupis. **tel. 782 930 252.**

Security, in the form of swimming units, will be ensured during the drill by the organiser of the drill - 15th Giżycko Mechanised Brigade.
