NOTICE No 66/2022

Pursuant to Art. 14 sec. 1 point 4 of the Act of 20 July 2017 – Water Law (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2021, item 2233 as amended) and Art. 43 sec. 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on Inland Navigation (Dz. U. /Journal of Laws/ of 2022, item 1097 as amended), the Regional Water Management Board in Gdańsk hereby informs that:

as of 21 November 2022, the reduction of navigation signage for the winter season has started on the following waterways:

- Nogat River km 0+000 to 62+000,
- Szarpawa River km 0+000 to 25+400.

At the same time, we would like to inform you that the floating signage has been completely removed on the following waterways:

- Brda River – the Vistula-Oder waterway at km 0+000 to 14+800,
- Elbląg Canal – all sections.

Therefore, navigation on the aforementioned waterways is only permitted if local navigational conditions are known and extreme caution is exercised.

From 21 November 2022, sluicing at the following locks of the Elbląg Canal is suspended until further notice: Zielona, Mała Ruś and Ostróda. The suspended sluicing is due to the appearance of ice in the sluice chambers.

Navigation on the Szarpawa River is restricted due to repairs to the drawbridge in Rybina at km 15+450. It is not possible to sail from the Vistula Lagoon to the Gdańska Głowa lock and vice versa.

Navigation on the Nogat River, due to the high water levels occurring during this period, may be restricted by the clearance under the bridge at Kępki at km 49+000.

In view of the above, we kindly request that you exercise particular caution and comply with applicable regulations.
